Over the past two decades, genetics and genomics have been shown to be very instrumental for the discovery and development of selected drugs, and to increase the probability of success for investigational molecules. The goal of the CERC is to harness the power of high throughput genomic sequencing, IT, AI and clinical investigations, and to capitalize on natural variations of the human genome, in order to position McGill at the forefront of genomics for drug discovery and development. During this seminar, Dr Mooser will share his vision for the CERC and the strategy he wants to develop to meet this objective.”
